


Guidelines to record your presentation

- As you know, The NSATRS 2024 is conducting as a 'virtual symposium' as our past symposia.
- Therefore, all the presenters to make the presentation 'online'.
- As we might face interruption in the real-time online presentations on the day of the symposium, the committee decided to request a 'recorded presentation' from all the presenters.
- All the presenters are requested to adhere to following guidelines on the making of recorded presentation (Duration **05 minutes** for the presentation and 05 minutes for the Q&A session)

Recording your presentation


1. Under 'slide show' click 'record slide show'



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


2. Then turn 'mic' on (See bottom right corner)



When you record yourself, make sure to keep away from the background noises.


3. Then click 'Record' (See top left corner)




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4. Move slide by slide to record your presentation with your voice



5. After completion of recording, save the document as .mp4 format.



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6. Sending the video file to NSATRS

- Option 1: Directly send your video file (.mp4) / through Google Drive link to nsatrs@uciars.cmb.ac.lk by mentioning your Manuscript No.
- Option 2: Transfer your video file through https://wetransfer.com/ website to nsatrs@uciars.cmb.ac.lk by mentioning your Manuscript No.
